### 1. Objectifs et contenu du cours :

This course offers a practical approach to English grammar for intermediate to advanced learners. It is designed to improve students' grammatical accuracy and deepen their understanding of how grammar functions in both written and spoken English. The course aims to: (1) help students recognize and use a focused range of grammatical structures; (2) strengthen their ability to read texts with attention to grammatical nuance; and (3) develop their writing skills through the accurate and effective use of grammar. Students will engage in targeted exercises and in-class drills that build comfort and fluency with key grammatical forms. These will be reinforced through close readings of literary texts, which will serve as models of grammar in context. Writing assignments will then give students the opportunity to apply what they've learned in their own writing.
