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1. Objectifs et contenu du cours :

This course will be a fairly comprehensive survey of grammatical concepts / notions and how they are expressed (grammatically) in English. Students will broaden their knowledge of English grammar and better master the more complex grammatical intricacies of the language. The course will cover, but will not be limited to, the following topics :

- A look at standard as well as commonly used non-standard grammatical structures in English.
- Trends in English grammar and diachronic changes (changes that occur over time / are presently occurring).
- Tense, aspect, mood and voice (in the conjugation of verbs).
- Role of inversion (question formation, hypotheticals, stylistic uses, etc.).
- Modification (adjectival and adverbial)
- Grammatical number in the noun and its expression in English.
- Negation (and its various forms).
- Coordination and subordination.
- Morphology and its place / role in English grammar.
- Basic English Syntax (word order) in English.

Students will also be given to opportunity to suggest grammatical topics that they find curious or that they do not yet fully understand.
